This has reference to Department Order No. 30, series of 1996, copy attached, implementing the President's instructions to raise the ceilings for the delegated authority to conduct the bidding for infrastructure projects in the DPWH Regions and Districts on condition that said Regions and Districts are performing efficiently and honestly.

The criterion in Item 2-a of said Department Order is hereby amended as shown below, to better reflect the performance of the Regional Directors/District Engineers as a basis for the delegated authority to bid out projects.

The pertinent provisions of said Department Order incorporating said amendment are given below (in quotation marks):

"The implementation of the raised ceilings of delegated authority mentioned above shall be as follows:

## "1. General

"The ceilings of authority to bid out projects for all Regional Directors and all District Engineers are hereby raised to P15 million and P10 million per project, respectively:

## "2. Additional Ceilings

"Regional Directors and District Engineers who meet the following criteria shall have their ceilings of bid authority further raised to \$\mathbb{P}30\$ million and \$\mathbb{P}15\$ million, respectively:

"a. Percentage of actual accomplishment and slippage on infrastructure projects, per latest reports on DPWH Monitoring and Information Service

- "b. Percentage of infrastructure
  Projects with no major defects,
  per latest reports of the DPWH
  Quality Assurance Units - - - At least 60%
- "c. Road maintenance condition ratings, per latest reports of the DPWH Bureau of Maintenance - - - minimum rating of Fair

"Based on the ratings of the Regional Directors and District Engineers vis-a-vis the criteria in Item 2 above, this Office will issue the specific orders naming the Regional Directors and District Engineers to whom said ceilings of authority to bid out projects of P30 million and P15 million, respectively, shall be granted.

"The ratings based on the criteria in item 2 above shall be updated on a semestral basis."

This Order shall therefore, amend/supersede said Department Order No. 30 s., 1996 and all previous Department Orders and other issuances or portions thereof inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect immediately.
