SUBJECT: Payment of Concrete Works

To ease the financial burden of contractors and ensure the timely completion of projects, partial payment of concrete works is hereby authorized subject to the following conditions:

1. That the contractor shall apply in writing for such partial payment of concrete work;

2. That the District Engineer, Regional Director, Undersecretary concerned or Secretary, depending upon his limits of approving authority, approves the above request following its review, inspection, valuation and recommendation by the Project Engineer concerned;

3. That partial payment therein shall be up to a maximum of seventy percent (70%) of the cost of the work item as determined from the bid price;

4. That the cement, sand and gravel, to be used as ingredients of concrete shall pass the required quality tests on construction materials prior the concreting;

5. That trial mix shall be undertaken to determine the quantity of each ingredient necessary to attain the concrete strength requirement;

6. That partial payment to the contractor shall be made by inclusion of the same in his regular progress billing by adding the authorized value of these materials as determined per item (3) above to the net amount of the regular billing;

7. That the partial payment given per item (6) above shall be fully deducted from the contractor's next immediate monthly billing without prejudice to his submitting another request for payment upon submission/approval of another written request as described in item (1) above; and that subsequent payments and recoupments shall be as afore-described.

8. That final payment shall be made only after all concrete samples taken from actual concreting works have passed the strength requirements and that other provisions of the Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges are complied with.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
