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

Revised Criteria for Rating Quality Control in Project Implementation

In line with the main thrust and objective of Department to ensure proper quality and speed thru fast-track implementation of public works and highways projects, the Regional and Project Management Offices shall be rated as regard to the materials and construction quality control aspect of project implementation. This will be done in order to identify the weak responsibility areas in project implementation and undertake necessary steps to strengthen the quality assurance program of the Department. This rating shall also serve as one of the tools to professionalize the system of promotion and assignment of its personnel. In this connection, the following revised criteria for rating quality control in project implementation are hereby prescribed, for your guidance and compliance:

- The Bureau of Research and Standards (BRS) shall conduct the appraisal of quality control performance of all Regional and Project Management Offices for two periods per year: January to June and July to December.
- The findings of the Quality Assurance Units on projects assessed within a particular appraisal period shall be included in the rating.
- 3. The criteria for appraisal shall be the following:

- 4. The Overall Accumulated Points (OAP) of each Region shall be the average of the total points earned by the Regional Office and the District/City Offices.
- 5. The Overall Accumulated Points (OAP) of each Central Office PMOs (COPMOS) shall be the total points earned by their office divided by the total number of projects rated.
- 6. The performance level of the Regional and Project Management Officesshall be rated as follows:

OVERALL ACCUMULATED POINTS PERFORMANCE RATING Outstanding Very Satisfactory 71 - 80 Satisfactory 61 - 70 Fair Below 60 Unsatisfactory

- 7. Immediately after the end of each appraisal period, the BRS shall make a report to the Secretary thru the Undersecretary concerned, copy furnished the Regional/Project Management Office being appraised.
- 8. The Quality Control Performance Rating of each office shall be published in the official publication of the Department (DPWH Technical Journal) and outstanding performance will be commended by the Secretary.



9. The Quality Control Performance Rating shall be one of the factors that will be considered for future promotions/assignments.

This supersedes all existing memoranda/orders inconsistent hereto.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
