The Ad Hoc Committee shall undertake, among others,
the following activities:

1. Conduct physical accounting of the equipment in question.
2. Determine the period actually covered (idle time) as claimed by MADECCO.
3. Evaluate and compute rental rates based on ACEL rates.
4. Determine and reconcile how much MADECCO is entitled to less amounts already paid.
5. Submit a report incorporating its findings and recommendations.

To achieve its objectives, the Ad Hoc Committee shall have the power to administer oaths, issue subpoena ad testificandum and subpoena duces tecum and to engage the services of DPWH employee/s to render secretariat services.
