SUBJECT: Adoption of Revised Philippine Road Signs
Manual and Manual on Pavement Markings

Part of the thrust of the Government in providing better transportation service or greater mobility for the people is the on-going program of constructing safer roadways for motorists and pedestrians. In line with this program, the Ministry has underscored the need of installing road signs and markings along our highways by requiring our design engineers to incorporate them in any improvement plan or in the design of new roads.

In support to the road safety program, the Ministry, through the Traffic Engineering and Management (TEAM) Project, has published the revised edition of the Philippine Road Signs Manual as a more comprehensive guide for the design, fabrication and installation of road signs. Earlier, the TEAM Project Office (under the then Ministry of Public Highways) had also revised the Manual on Pavement Markings for the same purpose.

In order to promote the safety of the road users, it is hereby directed that the two revised manuals be adopted for official use effective immediately.

Copies of the subject manuals are hereby distributed to all concerned.
