Subject: Declaring Marcos Highway  
(Marikina-Infanta Road)  
as National Secondary  
Road in the provinces of  
Rizal, Laguna, & Quezon

Pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order No. 113, series of 1955, and Executive Order No. 459, current series, the Marcos Highway (Marikina-Infanta Road) from Km. 18.980 (along Marikina-Victoria Valley-Antipolo Road) in Marikina, Rizal and traversing Laguna to Km. 132.338 in Infanta, Quezon, with a total length of 113.358 Kms., is hereby declared a National Secondary Road, provided that the 20 m. minimum road right-of-way for titled lands, 60 m. for unpatented public lands and 120 m. for lands in forested areas are acquired.

The kilometer-stationings and lengths of the aforementioned highway within the three provinces are as follows:

1. Rizal - km. 18.980 to km. 76.702 . . . 57.722 kms.
2. Laguna - km. 76.702 to km. 92.308 . . . 15.606 "
3. Quezon - km. 92.308 to km. 132.338 . . . 40.030 "
