Subject: Supplement to D.O. No. 228 Re:
Guidelines in the Implementation
of Employment Generation Through
Countryside Development or
KABUHAYAN 2000

Pursuant to the President's directive, dated 09 November 1993, to implement the Employment Generation through Countryside Development or Kabuhayan 2000, Project Managers and all other concerned are hereby directed to implement projects under the Kabuhayan 2000 Program, in accordance with the following supplement to Department Order No. 228, Series of 1993:

1. Project Selection and Programming

Under the 1994 program, the Project Management Offices (PMOs) shall enroll at least 14% of the current year on-going, rescinded, and/or terminated locally funded projects under the Kabuhayan 2000 program. To the maximum extent possible, appropriate foreign-assisted funded projects shall be also be enrolled in the program.

For this purpose, per Section 2 of Executive Order No. 182, dated June 3, 1988, and Paragraph 2, Department Memorandum Circular No. 36, dated March 2, 1992, a Labor-Based/Equipment Supported (LB/ES) program of work, may be prepared/covered by part of an appropriation using the guidelines under Department Order 51 dated June 20, 1988 and identified as an enrolled project to be undertaken by LB/ES methods.

Thus, where appropriate, the part suitable to LB/ES methods of construction of on-going, rescinded, or terminated projects shall be segregated and submitted to the Central Labor Based-Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program Office for inclusion in the Kabuhayan 2000 Program (e.g hillside works and canal masonry along highways, desilting of drainage, river/sea walls, groins, spurs, guide bonds, ripraps, etc.).

For the current year program under the PMOs, the LB/ES list shall be received by the CLB/CARP Office on or before June 21, 1994, for consolidation and approval of the Secretary. Under the subsequent years, 1995-1996 Programs, the PMOs shall submit the list of proposed LB/ES projects using the format in Annex A, on or before end of November of the current year, to the CLB-CARP Office, for consolidation and approval of the Secretary.

2. Work Organization


For maximum employment, LB/ES projects shall be implemented by Pakyaw Contract. However, where constrained by the loan/grant agreements or by law, the PMOs may also undertake LB/ES project by regular contract, specifying in the design and to implementation consultants the application of LB/ES methods. LB/ES project implementation by contract shall be coordinated by the PMOs with the Regional and Central LB-CARP Offices and shall be authorized by the Secretary.

3. Monitoring and Reporting

The LB/ES projects under the PMOs shall be monitored as required under the Kabuhayan 2000 Program, and their status shall be reported to the Regional Directors and CLB/CARP Office, using the standard Kabuhayan 2000 report format.

In addition to the above, the requirement for hiring and documentation on employment under Department Order 51 and 210, both series of 1990, pursuant to Republic Act 6685, shall continue to be strictly enforced, and the required quarterly report shall be submitted to CLB/CARP Program Office.

This Order takes effect immediately. Any Department Orders, Memoranda/Instructions inconsistent herewith are hereby modified/repealed accordingly.
