SUBJECT: Designation of Phil.
Constructors Asso-
ciation (PCA) or
National Confederation
of Constructors Asso-
ciations of the Phils.,
Inc. (NACCAP) as PBAC
Non-Voting Members

Section IB 2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations, as amended, of PD 1594 provides that to ensure transparency of bidding process there should be one (1) qualified representative from a duly recognized constructors association who shall be non-voting member.

There are two (2) nationally recognized constructors associations. These are the Philippine Constructors Association (PCA) and the National Confederation of Constructors Associations of the Philippines, Inc. (NACCAP). However, in certain regions, provinces or cities there are also constructors associations which are not affiliated with either PCA or NACCAP. The representative of the local constructors association is sometimes designated non-voting member of the regional or district PBAC. Designation of the representative of the local constructors association as PBAC member in places where there are PCA and NACCAP local chapters has spawned controversy in some instances.

To obviate similar controversies and upon request of NACCAP, it is hereby ordered that in places where there are PCA or NACCAP local chapters, the representative of either PCA or NACCAP be designated non-voting PBAC member. However, where there are no PCA OR NACCAP local chapters, the qualified representative of the local constructors association shall be designated as non-voting PBAC member.
