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
Subject: Administrative Sanctions Against Joint
Venture (JV) Contractors for Non-
Participation on Joint Contractual
Undertakings

It has been observed that many contractors enter into joint venture agreements for purposes of prequalification and bidding, but do not actually participate in the execution of the projects awarded to them as joint venture partners. This practice has not only contributed to many delays and/or failures in project implementation, but has also made a mockery of the prequalification process of the Department.

In this connection, it is hereby directed that all the firms who prequalify as members of a joint venture but who later do not actively participate in the implementation of the project in the proportion indicated in their joint venture prequalification documents, shall be blacklisted and disallowed from participating in the bidding for DPWH projects for three years effective upon issuance of the blacklisting order.

All project implementing offices - PMOs, Regional and District Offices - are hereby directed to submit to the Assistant Secretary for Central PBAC the joint venture firms awarded with contracts, indicating the partner/s who are not actually participating in the execution of the projects. The Central PBAC shall then prepare the corresponding Department Orders blacklisting these erring contractors.
