SUBJECT: CREATION OF INTER-AGENCY TECHNICAL WORKING

COMMITTEE FOR THE MONUMENTING/STAKING OUT OF

THE MARIKINA VALLEY FAULT SYSTEM

To ensure a comprehensive, coordinated and sustained planning and implementation of the monumenting/staking out of the Marikina Valley Fault System, and such other fault traces that maybe identified by PHIVOLCS in Metro Manila, an Inter-Agency Technical Working Committee is hereby created, composed of the following:

The Committee shall have the following functions:

- 1. Formulate plans and programs for immediate and medium term implementation.
- Coordinate and monitor field activities of government agencies relative to the monumenting and delineation of fault zone limits.
- 3. Conduct dialogue with local government units, non-government organizations and affected residents, should the need arises.
- 4. Submit monthly reports to the Office of the Secretary, DPWH, thru the Director, Bureau of Design.

All expenses that will be incurred by the Committee in connection with the prosecution of this project shall be charged against funds released for this purpose, subject however, to strict compliance with pertinent auditing and accounting regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately.
