The Committee shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate plans and programs for immediate and medium term implementation.
2. Coordinate and monitor field activities of government agencies relative to the monumenting and delineation of fault zone limits.
3. Conduct dialogue with local government units, non-government organizations and affected residents, should the need arises.
4. Submit monthly reports to the Office of the Secretary, DPWH, thru the Director, Bureau of Design.

All expenses that will be incurred by the Committee in connection with the prosecution of this project shall be charged against funds released for this purpose, subject however, to strict compliance with pertinent auditing and accounting regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately.
