Committee for the Procurement of Contract for the Upgrading and Rehabilitation of the Existing Metro Manila Traffic Signal System into a "SMART" Project

In view of the Memorandum of Understanding signed during the occasion of the Official and Working Visit to Australia of H.E. President Fidel V. Ramos;

first,

by and between the Government of Australia (GOA), represented by Mr. Gordon Bilney, and the Government of the Philippines (GOP), represented by Secretary Domingo L. Siason;

and second,

by and between Secretary Rizalino S. Navarro, Department of Trade and Industry, and Mr. John Dougall, Managing Director, AWA Traffic and Information Systems; both dated August 22, 1995,

a Special Committee is hereby created in the DPWH Central Office to administer the evaluation of offer, negotiation, recommendations for award for the procurement of contract for the Upgrading and Rehabilitation of the existing Metro Manila traffic signal system into a "SMART" traffic signal system, which is proposed by AWA for financing under the Australian Government through the Development Import Finance Facility (DIFF) - Export Finance Insurance Corporation (EFIC) financial scheme.
