**SUBJECT: Reconstitution of the
National Building Code
Review Committee**

Pursuant to Section 5 – Review of Existing Laws, Rules and Regulations, Administrative Order (AO) No. 160 dated October 4, 2006, issued by Her Excellency President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo, mandating the DPWH to review the existing laws, rules and regulations and/or issue stricter rules and regulations on the construction and maintenance of billboards, the National Building Code Review Committee (NBCRC) and its Board of Consultants (BoC) that were organized thru Special Order No. 01 dated June 09, 2004 for the purpose of updating/amending the National Building Code of the Philippines (PD 1096) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) are hereby reactivated/ reconstituted and shall be composed of the following:

The Oversight Committees is hereby dissolved without prejudice to the work of the National Building Code Review Committee.

The National Building Code Review Committee shall undertake the following continuing activities:

1. Review/update/revise the Implementing Rules and Regulation of the National Building Code in pursuance to PD 1096 which will attune to the present Infrastructure development and Rule XX Signs shall serve as the guidelines on outdoor advertising signs/billboard; and
2. Preparation of recommendations to Congress in aid of legislation.

All expenses to be incurred in these activities and the honoraria/allowances of the personnel involved shall be charged against any available funds of the Department, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order supersedes previous issuances to the contrary and shall take effect until the completion of the aforesaid activities.
