1. Oversee and monitor the implementation of the DPWH Solid Waste Management specifically on:
  - a. Office Management Recycling
  - b. Facilities Management Recycling
  - c. Collection and transfer of recyclables
  - d. Disposal system
  - e. Conduct of Information and Educational Campaign (IEC) whenever necessary
2. Manage the proper use/implementation of the composting area and Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).
3. Determine and recommend the use of the proceeds of sales from recyclable materials for the final approval of the Advisory Committee.
4. Assist the Advisory Committee in the formulation of additional policies and guidelines on Solid Waste Management of the Department.
