- 1.0 In light of the recent security incident involving our old and non-operational website and as a precautionary measure in case this is an ongoing attack, the Online Blacklisting Portal (OBP) is temporarily undergoing system downtime as improvements are being worked on.¹
- 2.0 To ensure, however, that the Procuring Entities will be able to continue to post their issued Blacklisting Orders and access the Consolidated Blacklisting Report (CBR), the Government Procurement Policy Board Technical Support Office established an alternative platform while the OBP security is being reinforced.
- 3.0 To properly guide our PEs, please see below details to view and post Blacklisting Orders:

Please use the BO form (Appendix 1 - Attached) and make sure that the submitted BO is accomplished accordingly, reflecting complete information among others, the name of blacklisted entity, the duration of the issued BO, offense committed, name of the project/contract, location of project, Approved Budget of the Contract, and other sanctions – if any, and is approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity We likewise highly encourage the posting of issued BO/s on your respective agency website and official Social
