This is in view of the Termination of Contract for Default of **CTC BUILDERS AND SUPPLIES INC.** with address at Maharlika Highway, Balogo, Sorsogon City, for its failure to fully and faithfully comply with its contract obligations without valid cause, as approved by the Head of Implementing Office, DPWH – Camarines Sur 2<sup>nd</sup> DEO, through the issuance of Notice of Decision to Terminate Contract dated December 21, 2022, for the contract 22FE0066 – OO1: Bridge Program – Widening of Permanent Bridges – Aslong Bridge (B00383LZ) along Daang Maharlika (LZ), respectively. Hence, the blacklisting of **CTC BUILDERS AND SUPPLIES INC.** is hereby **approved**.

Given that the said contractor has been previously blacklisted/suspended for a period of one (1) year pursuant to Department Order No 61, Series of 2023 dated June 7, 2023, due to a similar offense in another contract, **CTC BUILDERS AND SUPPLIES INC.** is hereby **blacklisted/suspended for a period of two (2) years**, from participating in bidding of any government projects as and by way of Administrative Sanction, pursuant to Section 6.0 of Appendix 17, Uniform Guidelines for Blacklisting of Manufacturers, Suppliers, Distributors, Contractors and Consultants and Section 4.0 of Appendix 17, Sanctions and Grounds for Blacklisting, of the Implementing Rules and Regulations, as amended, of Republic Act 9184.

As such, pursuant to Section 8.0, Appendix 17 of the IRR of RA 9184, the above-mentioned Department Order shall be deemed terminated and shall be subsumed in the two (2) year blacklisting/suspension period.

This Blacklisting Order shall take effect immediately and shall not in any manner relieve CTC BUILDERS AND SUPPLIES INC. from any financial obligations related to or connected with its terminated contracts under the terms and conditions of the contracts and existing laws, rules and regulations, or such criminal liability under applicable laws, if warranted.
