SUBJECT: Compulsory Inclusion of Road Safety and Traffic Management Plans in all Detailed Engineering Design (DED) for Road and Bridge Plans

In line with the policy of the Department to protect motorists and vulnerable road users from hazard or accidents as well as to enhance the management of traffic during construction, all concerned offices involved in the preparation of plans are required to include the details of Road Safety and Traffic Management Plans in all Detailed Engineering Design (DED) for Road and Bridge plans.

The details of the said plan must be relevant to the proposed project and should be specific, but not limited to dimensions, sizes and schedules of all road safety and traffic facilities and in accordance with the below-listed references, to wit:

- Highway Safety Design Standards (2012 edition):
 - Part 1 – Road Safety Design
 - Part 2 – Road Signs and Pavement Markings
- Design Guidelines, Criteria and Standards (2015 edition)
- Other issuances/policies related to road safety and traffic management

This Order supersedes any previous issuances inconsistent herewith and shall take effect immediately.
