Justification:

Vira-Caganayan Road is a major local road which connects to most of the inner barangays of the Municipality of Tineg with an approximate length of nineteen (19) kilometers.

The scope of work, "Upgrading from gravel to paved" is changed to "widening of gravel road surface, Improvement of drainage and construction of Slope Protection Works" (Stone Masonry and Grouted Riprap). These scope of works are necessary and should be undertaken first in order to make the road passable and improve the drainage and other road components before it is to be upgraded from gravel to paved.

Based on our evaluation, the submitted request for modification of the said project is in order; hence, approval hereof is recommended.
