The entire stretch of the existing curb and gutter from the original station (GAA FY 2025) was proposed to be rehabilitated but upon further inspection various sections are still in good condition and therefore it is retained. Morever, construction of sidewalks and side canals with steel gratings was originally included in station K0256 + 951 - K0257 +683 which is part of the original station which is not feasible to construct in the new station limits. These resulted to the decrease in unit cost and increase in physical target.

 Portland Cement Concrete Pavement with Micro Synthetic Fibers, 300mm. thick was proposed as a replacement of reinforcing steel bars in order to expedite the construction process. The project includes the construction of Curb and Gutter, Warning and Regulatory Signs and Reflectorized Thermoplastic Pavement Markings.
