What is the measure?

Percentage of DPWH budget in the General Appropriations Act (GAA) allocated to Infrastructure Flagship Projects (IFPs)

% of IFP allocation = (Total DPWH IFPs GAA / Total DPWH allocation in GAA) x 100%

Total IFPs GAA = Total allocation for IFPs in the DPWH GAA budget (in Php Billion)

Infrastructure Flagship Projects = priority infrastructure projects identified by NEDA, duly approved by the President as Chairperson of the NEDA Board.
