NCSC ADVISORY NO. 01, SERIES OF 2024

**SUBJECT: PUBLIC INFORMATION ON THE REQUIREMENT FOR THE  
ISSUANCE OF SENIOR CITIZENS' IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED  
BY THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE – LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT  
(LCE-LGU) THROUGH THE OFFICE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS  
AFFAIRS (OSCA)**

The general public is hereby advised that, pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7432, otherwise known as "An Act to Maximize the Contribution of Senior Citizens to Nation Building, Grant Benefits and Special Privileges and for Other Purposes," as amended by RA No. 9994, otherwise known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010," only a resident **Filipino Citizen** who is **sixty (60) years old or above** can validly obtain a Senior Citizens' Identification Card issued by their Local Chief Executive of the Local Government Unit (LCE – LGU) through its respective Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) in all cities and municipalities.

The general public is likewise warned that it is unlawful for any person to misrepresent himself/herself as a Filipino senior citizen. Section 4, Article 24, Rule VII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9994 provides that "If the offender is an alien or a foreigner, he/she shall be deported immediately after service of sentence without further deportation proceedings".

Please be guided accordingly.
