
PROJECT BRIEFER

The North Luzon East Expressway (NLEE) project has an estimated length of 92 km and will start at Del Monte-Norzagaray Road in Barangay Bigte, Norzagaray, Bulacan and will terminate at Central Luzon Link Expressway (CLLEX) Phase II at its Cabanatuan Interchange. The project was initially divided into four (4) road segments as follows:

The project is proposed to be a full-access controlled toll expressway with four lanes traversing two (2) cities and seven (7) municipalities along Bulacan and Nueva Ecija Provinces in Central Luzon Region.

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PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To reduce travel time from three (3) hours to just about one (1) hour from Norzagaray, Bulacan to Cabanatuan, Nueva Ecija.
- To spur provincial and regional economic activities and provide improved and prompt delivery of services to people in the serviced areas
- To enhance transport network and accessibility between provinces and municipalities particularly in North Luzon Region.
