PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Panguil Bay Bridge is a two-way, two-lane 3.17 km bridge (2.24 km bridge and 0.929 km approach road component) located in Panguil Bay, Northern Mindanao (Region X) that connects the provinces of Misamis Occidental and Lanao Del Norte. This infrastructure flagship project is Mindanao's longest sea-crossing bridge with the total investment cost funded through an Official Development Assistance loan with the Korean ExportImport Bank - Economic Development Cooperation Fund ("KEDCF"). The bridge construction started on February 28, 2020 and was inaugurated on September 27. 2024. The Operation Maintenance (O&M) of the project will be assessed for its viability as a PPP.
