In view of DO #151 Series of 2016 prescribing the use of DPWH Procurement Manual dated June 2016, all participating bidders urge to use A4 size bond paper for the Technical and Financial Documents (duly accomplished forms) as specified in the Bidding Documents (BD's) in two (2) separate sealed bid envelopes to the BAC Chairman;
- iv. The proprietor/manager/secretary/duly designated liaison officer of the firm, are the only appropriate persons who will be acknowledged by the BAC in all the procurement process; Furthermore, based on the Memo dated July 24, 2015, the BAC can now view the authorized liaison officer of the contractor submitting its bid from the contact person verification function of the CWR to prevent unauthorized submission of bids.
- v. Based on Article VIII, Sec. 25 of R.A. 9184 that the Bids shall be received by the BAC on such date, time and place specified in the invitation to bid. The deadline for the receipt of bids shall be fixed by the BAC, giving it sufficient time to complete the bidding process and giving the prospective bidder's sufficient time to study and prepare their bids. The deadline shall also consider the urgency of the procurement involved. Bids submitted after the deadline shall not be accepted.

Questions and Comments from Bidders and Responses of BAC and Other DPWH Officials:

- Engr. Piape asked if the project was under IAO. Then, he asked if it was okay that it was under IAO.
- Engr. Bebero, BAC Secretariat Head, responded that in the past, it was under IAO.
- Mr. Cantero, ICT Unit representative, informed the BAC that the COA Office was included in the offices that will be transferred temporarily.
- Engr. Piape told Mr. Cantero that the offices that will be temporarily transfer to the covered court were the Construction Section, Planning and Design Section and Maintenance Section.
- Mr. Cantero responded that since it was part of the main building, they just anticipated
 it.
- Engr. Piape asked if it was still okay even if the COA office will be transferred temporarily at the QAS office.
- Mr. Cantero responded that it will be okay. Then, he informed the BAC that the only thing they needed was the floor plan, in order for them to know the division of the cubicles.
- Engr. Piape expressed that the floor plan should be arranged already, so that it can be determined. Then, he asked if the materials included in this procurement of goods will be enough even if there was no floor plan yet.
- Mr. Cantero responded that they have already anticipated this, that was why they have included the access point wireless.
- Engr. Ariate asked if this can be reused if they will transfer to the new building.
- Mr. Cantero confirmed that this can be reused or reinstalled, therefore, there will be no waste.
- Engr. Piape asked about the amount of the canvassed materials.
- Mr. Cantero responded that they have benchmarked at Butuan City DEO and the Regional Office, since they have similar situation before.
- Engr. Piape asked if there was a POW for this, since there was an inclusion of labor.
- Mr. Cantero responded that it was under Goods but the services were included.
- Engr. Piape asked if they will not be questioned by the COA on how they have come
 up with the labor. Then, he asked the body if they will have to include the labor in the
 title of the project.
- Engr. Ariate responded that the labor should be different from the procurement of goods since it was not a material. He suggested that it should be procurement of the materials and the labor should not be included. Later, he suggested that maybe it should be "including installation" not "labor".
- Mr. Cantero expressed that this means the title will be changed.
- The BAC agreed that it will be changed, wherein the word "labor" should be removed, since there was already a word "installation" there.
- Engr. Ariate asked what the term "termination" in the title was for.
- Mr. Cantero responded that when the nodes will be installed, it needs to be terminated for it to be used. Then, he informed the BAC that based on the meeting he attended, the warranty of the wirings will be void, since the reason it will be removed was not because of natural disaster.

- Engr. Piape asked if this means that it will be another labor cost for just the removal.
- Mr. Cantero asked if it will be okay to integrate it in this project.
- Engr. Piape asked for clarification if he was referring about this project being presented.
- Mr. Cantero confirmed that he was referring about this project.
- Engr. Piape expressed that this means that there will be labor included which needs a POW.
- Mr. Cantero responded that it will be a different POW.
- Engr. Piape responded that it cannot be because only materials were being procured in this project. He added that he cannot add-on the labor cost to the amount of the materials. Later, he asked what P.I.U. means in the project title.
- Mr. Cantero responded that it stands for Public Information Unit.
- Engr. Cabrera asked if the wirings that were removed will still be used.
- Mr. Cantero responded that whatever that can be utilized, then it can be used.

- Engr. Piape asked if it will not be a violation if this will be charged under IAO.
- The BAC Secretariat staff informed the BAC that according to Mr. Pazo of Procurement Unit, it was under IAO 2025 funds.
- Engr. Piape asked why it was not under 2024. Then, he asked if whoever will be the supplier of the materials will also be the one who will install the materials.
- Mr. Cantero confirmed that whoever will be the supplier of the materials will also be the one who will install it. He added that they will not accept if the supplier cannot connect it to the DPWH Intranet.
- Engr. Piape asked about the warranty.
- Engr. Ariate asked if it was included in the conditions.
- Engr. Piape asked how will they pursue the supplier for this.
- Mr. Cantero responded that he will pursue them through the certification from the Central Office, since they will still have to request for the specification of the equipment.
- Engr. Piape asked for clarification if they still have to make a request for this project.
- Mr. Cantero responded that they should have, since he cannot make a request without the project ID.
- Engr. Ariate expressed that he should have taken the project ID during the Preprocurement Conference. Then, he asked for the number of days that they will have to wait for the approval.
- Mr. Cantero responded that it will be a week. Then, he asked when the project ID was issued for this project.


