Justification:

- Modification for this project is necessary due to the decrease in physical target in the first component. The said reduction in the physical target will serve as a correction from the assumed 4-lane road construction to only 2 lanes based on the approved Detailed Engineering Design (DED).
- Corresponding increase in the unit cost for CW-1 was due to the completion of road network elements (i.e. bike lanes and sidewalks) per approved DED Plans. The physical target reflected the scope along the carriageway not the appurtenances to be constructed in the actual works.

Based on our evaluation, the submitted request for modification of the said project is in order; hence, approval hereof is recommended.
